Welcome to Black Country Living Museum

A registered charity, the Museum opened to the public in 1978 and has expanded to encompass over 60 historical buildings, either translocated from their original home, or built as a replica to help recreate over 250 years of history of the Black Country for visitors near and far.

- In 2012, the Museum was awarded designated status by Arts Council England and became a National Portfolio Organisation in 2018.
 - In 2024, the Museum saw over 350,000 visitors over the year.
 - In 2024, the Museum saw over 48,000 school pupils from over 870 schools.
- So far, our Little Makers Programme has offered 4,000 Key Stage 1 students the chance to learn about local history and enjoy creative and cultural experiences they may not otherwise have been able to access.
 - There are 182 Active Volunteers working to date, with 56 Corporate Volunteers in 2024.
- The Museum is passionate about community and holds community panels and support groups for carers of those living with Dementia.
- The Museum helps to tell impactful stories across 250 years such as the story of Windrush, Post-War Black Country, and The Women Chainmakers of Cradley Heath.

By Road

For all corporate events, please make your way to Car Park 2 located off Tipton Road.

When approaching from Castle Gate island (south of the Museum): exit the roundabout onto Tipton Road (A4037). Go past the set of traffic lights where you will see 'The Archives' located on your left. Immediately after The Archives, please turn left into Car Park 2.

When approaching from Birmingham New Road (north of the Museum): go straight over at the lights and join Tipton Road (A4037). Before the traffic lights, use the filter lane to turn right into Car Park 2.

Please note, car parking for corporate events is included within our prices.

By Rail

We are 1 mile from Tipton Train Station, which is on the Birmingham to Wolverhampton line operated by West Midlands Railway. Plan your journey and check train timetables using the National Rail Enquiries website or by calling 08457 48 49 50.
